

## SIP Web Site IP Data Base Expansion

Currently, the SIP web site data base of *The Israel Philatelist* contains journals from 1948 through 2015. Since 2015, there have been 20 new issues printed but not added to the data base. We inquired of our web hosting company if it was possible to add these issues to the database since they were on the web site and already high resolution PDFs. They replied that it is possible, but some changes need to be made to the data base program and server.

The changes involved moving the current database file to a different server and adding some code to read the new journal's PDFs. Also, code needs to be inserted to make it possible to have the editor or administrative assistant add the latest journals to the database. They estimated the cost to do this work to be \$2,000.

In discussing the project with my daughter over a cup of tea at Starbucks, she offered \$1,000 to the project. She stipulated that the money would be matching fund donation. *This an official announcement that the SIP Web Data Base Expansion Fund is now open for donations.*
