• The member will be responsible for any USPS return fee, USPS postage due payment for their new address notification, and the costs for resending *The Israel Philatelist*.







HELP WANTED

The searchable database of *The Israel Philatelist* is complete to 2015. To input all the journals, *Modgility* (our web hosting company) needed to have scanned PDF files. Unfortunately, the journal's early issues were not adequately printed, resulting in poor scans and conversion to readable PDF files.

The problem is that many of the early journals need to be manually retyped and corrected in the computer. The typing is a very time-consuming process and has been in progress for the last several years.

The problem is our Administrative Assistants and Vicki Galecki are the only ones doing the typing. Their time is very limited, so progress is slow. My best guess is that we are at least 50% done with the corrections.


